

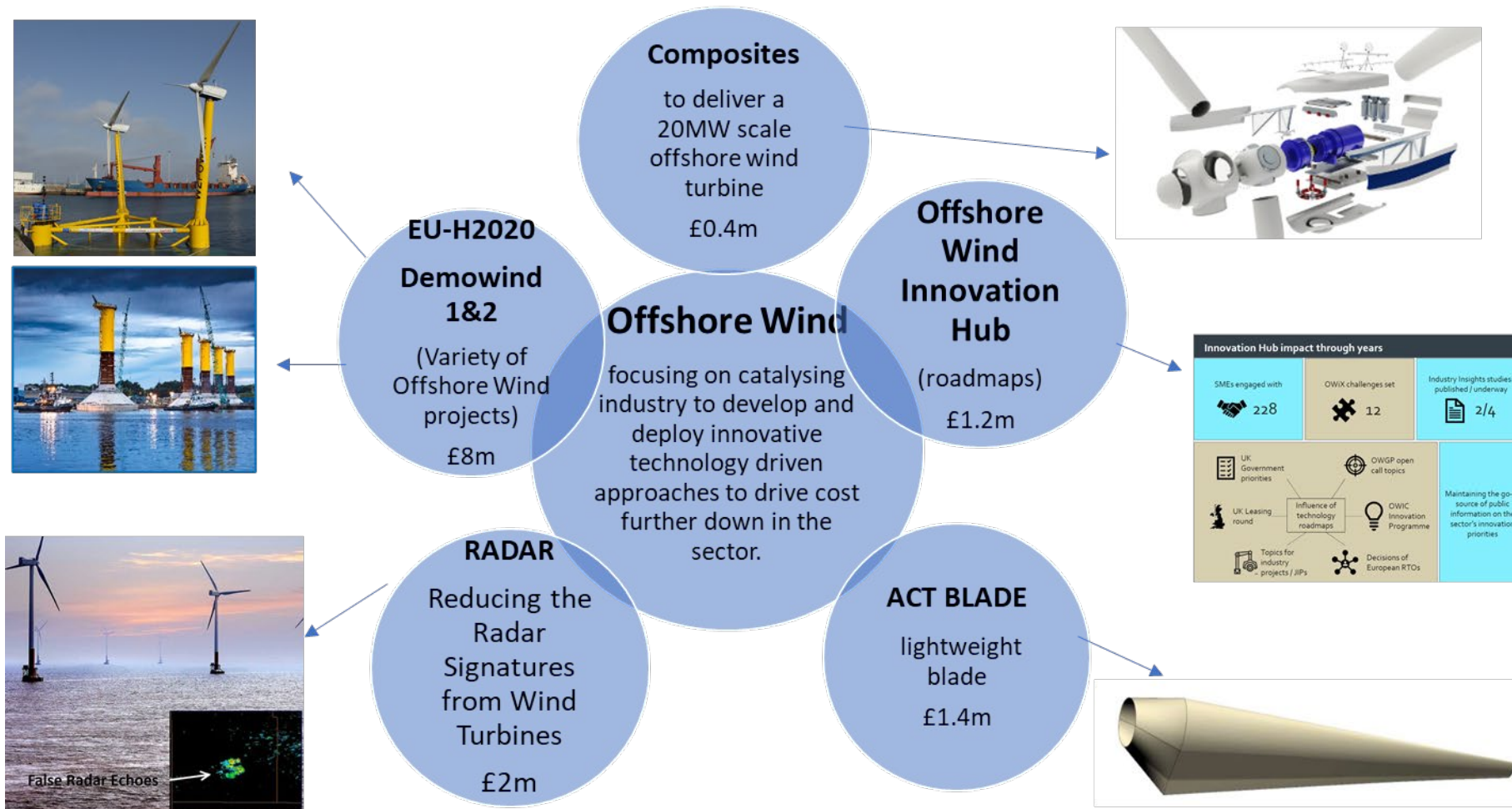

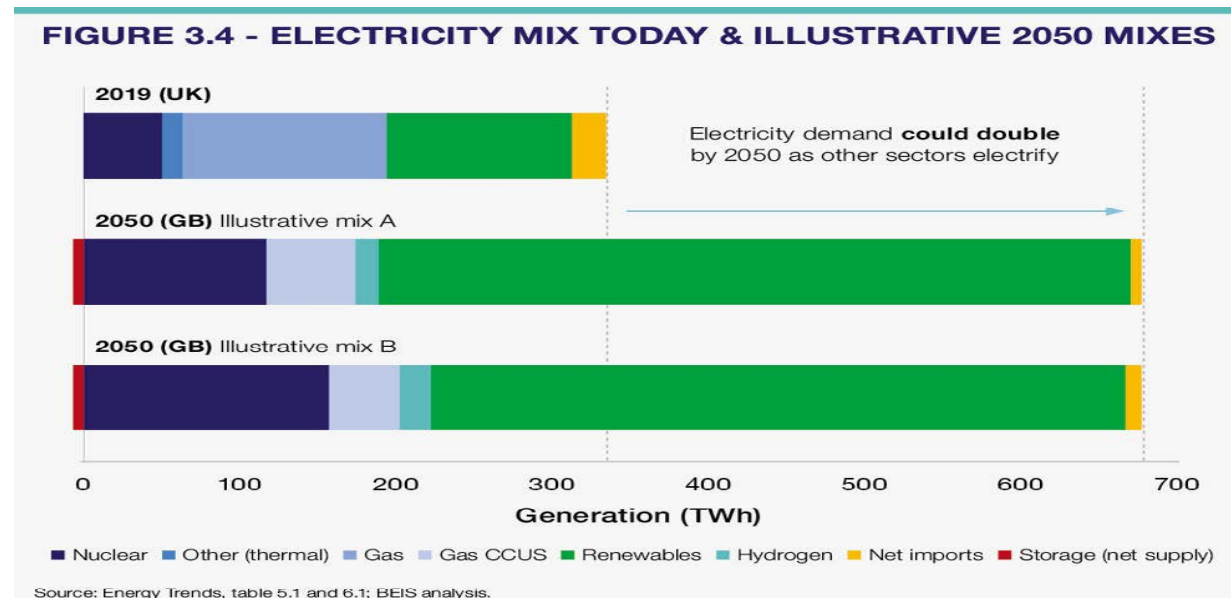


We are here - Point A.
